

**SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY**  
**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO INCREASE ELECTRIC RATES**  
**APPLICATION NO. A.05-11-008**

On November 10, 2005, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) and Southern California Edison Company (SCE) filed a joint application with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to set contribution levels for each company's nuclear decommissioning trust fund and other related issues in connection with San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) Unit 1, 2 and 3.<sup>1</sup> In this application SDG&E requested an increase to its revenue requirement to cover increased contributions to its nuclear decommissioning trust funds for SONGS 2 & 3 beginning in January 2007. The current annual revenue requirement to cover contributions to SDG&E's trust funds is \$6.7 million. SDG&E is requesting an increase to \$12.2 million annually. There will be no bill impact the first year (2007) due to an offsetting reduction in other costs collected from customers. Beginning in 2008, the bill impact will reflect an annual increase in revenue requirement of \$5.5 million.

**EFFECT ON ELECTRIC RATES AND BILLS**

If the CPUC approves SDG&E's request, a typical non-CARE residential customer's summer electric bill using 500 kilowatt-hours of electricity will increase from \$70.25 per month to \$70.27 per month, or 2 cents, on January 1, 2008. The impact on each customer and customer class could vary depending on the CPUC's final decision. The following table shows the rate changes SDG&E is requesting in this application. The actual rates approved by the CPUC may be higher or lower than those requested by SDG&E.

<sup>1</sup> SCE owns an 80% interest in SONGS 1 and a 75.05% interest in SONGS 2 & 3. SDG&E owns a 20% interest in SONGS 1, 2 and 3. The City of Anaheim and the City of Riverside own the remaining 3.16% and 1.79% interests in SONGS 2&3, respectively.

### THE CPUC WILL HOLD EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS

Before acting on our application, the CPUC will hold evidentiary hearings to examine evidence and hear testimony presented by SDG&E and any other interested parties, including the CPUC's Office of Ratepayer Advocates (ORA). After considering all evidence presented, the CPUC will issue a decision. The CPUC may approve a nuclear decommissioning trust fund revenue requirement that differs from those requested by SDG&E.
