NOTICE OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION HEARINGS AND PUBLIC WORKSHOP REGARDING SDG&E'S APPLICATION FOR REVIEW OF PROACTIVE DE-ENERGIZATION PROCEDURES AND CHANGES TO TARIFF RULE 14.

On December 10, 2008, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E®) filed a proposed application with the CPUC seeking review of its Proactive De-energization (Emergency Power Shut-Off) procedures and approval of changes to Tariff Rule 14 – Shortage of Electric Supply and Interruption of Delivery. SDG&E's application describes the proactive de-energization measures where, under certain extreme weather conditions and in limited high-fire-risk areas, SDG&E would shut off power to limited portions of the distribution system and/or tie lines (69 kV transmission lines). This filing also proposes changes to Tariff Rule 14, which addresses responsibility for losses that are incurred by customers due to an interruption of electricity delivery for a variety of reasons, including those times when power delivery is interrupted for public safety. The Public Participation Hearings (PPHs) and public workshop for this proceeding have been finalized and are noted below:
