NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE DECREASE
APPLICATION NO. A.06-08-026

On August 28, 2006, San Diego Gas and Electric Company (SDG&E) filed an application (A.06-08-026) with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) to revise its rates for gas service. Specifically, this application proposes to revise SDG&E's rates consistent with settlement agreements reached with plaintiffs in class-action litigation related to the Western U.S. energy crisis of 2000-01 and with Southern California Edison Company. These settlements address a number of structural changes to the gas operations of SDG&E and propose to combine the core gas procurement functions of SDG&E and the Southern California Gas Company. SDG&E believes the proposed combined core portfolio will provide long-term economic benefits to core customers of both utilities by providing reduced costs of regulation, increased supply diversity and reduced administrative costs. The combination of the gas procurement functions provide the only immediate direct impact on rates in A.06-08-026.

In this application, SDG&E proposes an overall rate decrease in gas transportation rates of \$4.9 million, or 2.2% for SDG&E customers. A typical winter residential bill for an SDG&E residential customer using 50 therms will decrease by \$0.58 under the proposed rates, from the average of \$68.01 under present rates. Proposed rates on average for SDG&E's commercial and industrial customers, and NGV customers, will also decrease.

WHAT THIS MEANS TO YOU

The following table shows the transportation revenue impact (excluding franchise fees and uncollectibles) of SDG&E's proposal to each customer class:

* PPP stands for the Public Purpose Programs surcharge. The revenues fund certain state-mandated programs. Including income-qualified subsidy programs, conservation and research and development.

The impact on each customer and each customer class could vary depending on individual usage and the Commission's final decision.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

Before acting on SDG&E's application, the Commission may hold formal evidentiary hearings that will be open to the public and devoted to analyzing the need for the requested changes. At these hearings, the Commission will accept testimony from SDG&E and other interested parties who may offer proposals that differ from those requested by SDG&E. After considering all the proposals, the Commission will issue a decision.
