## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION HEARINGS REGARDING ORDER INSTITUTING RULEMAKING TO REVISE AND CLARIFY COMMISSION REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE SAFETY OF ELECTRIC UTILITY AND COMMUNICATIONS INFRASTRUCTURE PROVIDER FACILITIES (R.08-11-005)**

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is considering revising and clarifying the CPUC's regulations designed to protect the public from potential hazards, including fires, which may be caused by the electric utility transmission or distribution lines or communication infrastructure providers' facilities in proximity to electric overhead transmission or distribution lines. The rulemaking encompasses electric lines that belong to non-electric utilities and publicly owned utilities.
