SERVICE TO UTILITY EMPLOYEES

APPLICABILITY

Applicable to gas service for residential purposes by utility employees in accordance with special conditions set forth herein.

TERRITORY

Within territory served directly by the utility through individual meters for each single-family housing unit.

RATES

The billing as determined under a regularly filed schedule for residential service which would otherwise be applicable, less 25% discount.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. This schedule shall be available only to regular employees who have been continuously employed by the utility for more than twelve (12) months, and to retired employees who were employed by the utility for more than ten (10) years and were retired under the utility's pension plan. This schedule is not applicable to provisional, temporary, short-term, part-time or call-in employees, nor to regular employees on leave of absence in excess of thirty (30) days. This schedule is not applicable to employees or annuitants who, during the 12 months prior to application for service under this schedule, had his service discontinued for nonpayment of a bill for service.
2. This schedule will apply only to a single dwelling unit which is the place of residence of the employee or annuitant, where such eligible person is head of the household served (or that person's spouse), or where he or she lives with and constitutes the support of a mother and/or father or other immediate family.
3. Service under this schedule is available only upon written application being made by the employee or annuitant and the discount will be discontinued upon termination of eligibility of such person or upon cessation of payment of bills directly by the employee or annuitant.
4. If service to an employee or annuitant is discontinued for nonpayment of a bill for service, the employee or annuitant shall become ineligible for service under this schedule for 12 monthly billing periods after the date service is discontinued. Reinstatement of the discount will be in accordance with Special Condition 1.
