Dear Resident or Property Owner:

San Diego Gas & Electric Company's highest priority is providing you with safe and reliable natural gas and electric service. As part of our commitment to you, we periodically need to make improvements to our facilities within your community to enhance system reliability.

You may have received previous notices regarding the first phase Del Mar Reconfiguration Project (Project). We experienced a delay to our project schedule, however, this notice is to inform you that construction activities associated with the second and third phases of the Project will begin in October 2022. Construction activities associated with Phases Two and Three are provided below.

Phase Two – Conversion of overhead circuits to underground

Phase Two of this Project is anticipated to resume in October 2022. The initial work associated with this phase was completed in March 2022, including survey work and potholing along a 3,600 foot section of San Dieguito Drive and Racetrack View Drive and a 600 foot section along Sorrento Valley Road near Peñasquitos Creek. Construction activities associated with the conversion of existing distribution circuits in these areas from an overhead to underground configuration will involve trenching, installation of underground vaults and cable, installation of four distribution poles, overhead wire work and paving.

Phase Three – Pole removals and reconfigurations

The final phase of the Project is expected to begin in November 2022 and will continue through first quarter 2023. The scope of work extends from Del Mar Substation on Via de la Valle, continuing south on Jimmy Durante Boulevard through the San Dieguito Lagoon into Del Mar Heights, crossing the Los Peñasquitos Lagoon, terminating at Vista Sorrento Parkway, just south of Pacific Plaza Drive near Interstate 5.

This phase includes reconfiguration or replacement of existing wooden poles and the permanent removal of 35 transmission poles and conductor in lagoon areas and the Torrey Pines State Reserve. All work activities will take place 7 am – 7 pm, Monday to Friday. Traffic control measures will be in place during construction.

Traffic delays and temporary lane closures are expected. We plan to have traffic control measures in place during construction, and our crews will strive to minimize any impacts to you and your neighbors. We encourage you to adjust commuting plans as necessary.

Location: City of Del Mar & City of San Diego
Work Days: Monday - Friday
Hours: 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. (unless otherwise allowed by permits)
Duration: Approximately 9 months

Construction activities may take place in phases. This means work along the route will often occur intermittently and all construction activities required in a certain area will not be completed concurrently. Also, there will be multiple construction locations and activities taking place simultaneously, with work hours, traffic control measures, and noise restrictions for each area established by local jurisdictions. Please note, construction dates are subject to change according to compliance requirements, inclement weather, or other unforeseen circumstances. We'll provide additional updates should construction dates change.

Helicopters and/or drones may be utilized for construction, inspection and support activities. The use of helicopters and/or drones may temporarily increase local noise levels, dust, and other disturbances. Should helicopters or drones be needed during construction, SDG&E® will endeavor to minimize the impact of aerial operations. Noise and dust disturbances may increase due to construction activities. To reduce possible disturbance during potential aerial operations, as well as noise from other construction activities, we advise you to close all doors and windows to homes and buildings.

As part of this Project, temporary construction support sites will be required along the alignment. These sites will serve as temporary storage for materials and equipment and will be used for parking during construction hours. These temporary sites will be restored to their original condition and use upon completion of the Project.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience you may experience during construction activities. SDG&E will continue to work closely with local municipalities and community groups to ensure construction activities are as least disruptive as possible. We also plan to keep communities informed during all phases of the Project's construction. We're committed to working with you and local public safety officials to help minimize inconveniences and safeguard a smooth construction process.
