Dear Resident or Property Owner:

San Diego Gas & Electric Company's highest priority is providing you with safe and reliable natural gas and electric service. As part of our commitment to you, we periodically need to make improvements to our facilities within your community to enhance system reliability.

You may have received previous notices regarding the Del Mar Reconfiguration Project. We experienced a delay to our project schedule, however, this notice is to inform you that construction activities will begin January 10, 2022.

This project includes construction activities at SDG&E's existing Del Mar Substation immediately northwest of the intersection of Interstate 5 and Via De La Valle, and east along Via De La Valle approximately 1.1 miles to the intersection of El Camino Real in San Diego. SDG&E[®] will install a new one-mile section of 69 kilovolt underground transmission line within Villa De La Valle, and two new poles on the east end inside the Horsepark property.

Construction along Via De La Valle will take place Sunday through Thursday from 9pm to 5am unless otherwise directed by local traffic control permits.

Traffic delays and temporary lane closures are expected. We plan to have traffic control measures in place during construction, and our crews will strive to minimize any impacts to you and your neighbors. We encourage you to adjust commuting plans as necessary.

Construction dates are subject to change according to compliance requirements, inclement weather, or other unforeseen circumstances. We'll provide additional updates should construction dates change.

As part of this project, temporary construction support sites will be required along the alignment. These sites will serve as temporary storage for materials and equipment and will be used for parking during construction hours. These temporary sites will be restored to their original condition and use upon completion of the project.

We apologize in advance for any inconvenience you may experience during construction activities. SDG&E will continue to work closely with local municipalities and community groups to ensure construction activities are as least disruptive as possible. We also plan to keep communities informed during all phases of the project's construction. We're committed to working with you and local public safety officials to help minimize inconveniences and safeguard a smooth construction process.
