


# Electric Bundled<sup>1</sup> Residential Average Rate Breakout

January 1, 2026<sup>2</sup>



A typical non-solar customer's monthly bill includes approximately \$40 (21%)<sup>3</sup> due to NEM program costs

# What goes into residential electric rates

**Transmission:** Costs associated with transmission infrastructure, which brings energy into the San Diego region. These costs are approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

**Distribution:** Costs related to the construction and maintenance of safe and reliable distribution infrastructure.

**Wildfire-related:** Expenses for wildfire mitigation activities and other related costs, such as contributions to the statewide wildfire fund.

**Energization:** Costs associated with transportation electrification and other relevant activities.

**Metering & Billing:** Costs related to metering and billing services.

**CEMA (Catastrophic Event Memorandum Account):** Costs associated with catastrophic events and emergencies.

**Commodity:** The cost to procure energy on your behalf and some utility-owned generation.

**EE (Energy Efficiency):** Costs to provide energy efficiency programs to customers, including costs collected on behalf of the San Diego Regional Energy Network.

**Unrecovered Arrearages:** Costs associated with uncollectible residential debt, including the Arrearage Management Payment plan.

**PPP (Public Purpose Programs):** Costs associated with certain state-mandated programs, such as low-income assistance and the ongoing operation of Diablo Canyon Power Plant.

**Insurance:** Costs related to insurance coverage.

**Taxes:** Includes property, payroll, and income taxes.

**Other:** Additional costs included in delivery rates that all customers pay, such as energy storage and nuclear decommissioning.
