As part of San Diego Gas & Electric's ongoing effort to reduce grid loads and minimize the impacts of Public Safety Power Shutoffs (PSPS) during adverse weather conditions, we have implemented the Microgrid Program. The Boulevard Microgrid has been ordered by the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) as one of four circuit-level microgrid projects that are to be online no later than Q3 2023. The microgrid will provide resiliency to critical shared resource customers connected to the site.

The Boulevard substation Microgrid Project will install a battery energy storage system. The project site is adjacent to the current Boulevard substation.

The construction is scheduled to commence in July 2022 and will take approximately 12 months to complete. Construction will take place Monday through Saturday. Please note, construction hours and times are subject to local ordinances. Construction activities may take place in phases. There will be multiple construction locations and activities taking place simultaneously, with work hours, traffic control measures, and noise restrictions for each area established by local jurisdictions. Please note, construction dates are subject to change according to compliance requirements, inclement weather, or other unforeseen circumstances. We will provide additional updates should construction dates change.

SDG&E® understands that construction noise and activities can be frustrating, especially while many residents are working from home. We endeavor to keep construction traffic and noise to a minimum and will implement mitigation measures to reduce these potential impacts, when applicable.

We will continue to work closely with local municipalities and community groups to ensure construction activities are as least disruptive as possible. We are committed to working with you and local public safety officials to help minimize inconveniences and safeguard a smooth construction process.

We too, live and work in the communities where construction is taking place. SDG&E respects your streets and neighborhoods by driving and working safely and with respect to the

environment and surrounding communities. We apologize in advance for any inconvenience during this time.
