

**ENERGY DIVISION DATA REQUEST**  
**ED-SDG&E-DR-01**  
**SDG&E SECOND AMENDED GRC Phase 2 APPLICATION – A.15-04-012**  
**DATE RECEIVED: AUG 1, 2016**

Energy Division requests billing determinant data from a random sample of schools for the most recently available 24-month period, for the current and proposed TOU periods. This will entail obtaining the following metered data:

- Monthly usage in each TOU period;
- monthly maximum 15-minute interval usage; and
- Monthly maximum 15-minute interval usage during the peak TOU period.

The data should be obtained from a representative sample of schools (i.e. at least 25% of schools that are SDG&E customers) that:

- Have installed solar capacity and are located in either inland or coastal climate zones; and
- Do not have installed solar capacity and are located in either inland or coastal climate zones.

So the sampling matrix should look like this:
