With the Economic Development Rate, eligible businesses can receive a 12% discount* on monthly bills for a period of 5 years.

This offering is for you if you are a:

- Non-residential, non-governmental business customer that might relocate out of state.
- Business that would cease operations in California without the benefit of the EDR offering.
- Business that will relocate to SDG&E's service territory from outside of the State of California.
- Bundled service business customer, or a business customer served by Direct Access or Community Choice Aggregation.**
 All three customer types may qualify.

Under the EDR offer, your company agrees to:

- Create and/or retain jobs in California.
- Supply documentation of out-of-state choices or operational scenarios.***
- Sign an affidavit stating that EDR is an influencing factor in your decision to locate within the SDG&E service territory.

Is there a limitation?

The EDR pricing is available until the 40MW program cap is met:

- 10MW for businesses equal to or less than 150kW
- 30MW for businesses greater than 150kW
