STATEWIDE AND LOCAL EX POST LOAD IMPACT REPORTS**

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Pursuant to Rule 1.9 of the Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (“SDG&E” or the “Utility”) provides notice to the service lists in Rulemaking (“R.”)07-01-041 and Application (“A.”) 11-03-001 *et al.*, that the ex post load impact reports reflecting program year 2011 and as described below have been posted on SDG&E’s website. The load impact reports are being posted in accordance with Load Impact Protocol 27 adopted in Decision (“D.”) 08-04-050 and modified by D.10-03-006. As of April 2, 2012, a decision has not been issued by the Commission on the Investor-owned Utilities’ 2012-2014 demand response applications. Therefore, it is not possible for SDG&E to post ex ante forecasts that incorporate the results of the adopted decision. SDG&E’s ex ante forecasts previously prepared and filed in April 2011 can be found on the Utility’s website. SDG&E will file an updated ex ante forecast, including an Executive Summary, on June 1, 2012
