QUESTION 7.1:

With respect to SoCalGas' response to SCGC-06, Question 6.3, please explain why SoCalGas/SDG&E's response failed to include reference to facilities that fall within the "Other Storage Plant" category.

RESPONSE 7.1:

SoCalGas and SDG&E object to this question on the grounds that it is ambiguous and confusing. SCGC-Data Request-06, Question 6.3 questions why SoCalGas/SDG&E never considered using a storage facility as a means of meeting demands on the Southern System. It is unclear how "facilities that fall within the 'Other Storage Plant' category would fit with this question or our answer.

- 7.2.19 If the answer to previous question is “yes,” please identify the entity to which the land was sold or transferred.
