



Natural Gas Rate Change Alert

Throughout the year, we submit requests to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) to change our rates. On December 28, 2023, San Diego Gas & Electric (SDG&E) filed Advice Letter 3261-G to consolidate all the previously approved gas transportation rate change requests. As a result, SDG&E's bundled (gas transportation, public purpose surcharge and gas commodity) residential average gas rates will decrease by approximately 1 cent/therm or 0.3% from \$2.28/therm to \$2.27/therm.¹

Estimated Annual Residential Bill Impacts of All Approved Gas Rate Changes from 2023 ²				
Type of Customer	Current Monthly Bill	Proposed Impact	New Monthly Bill	% Decrease
Non-CARE	\$55	-\$0.16	\$55	-0.3%
CARE	\$35	-\$0.27	\$35	-0.8%

Customers enrolled in the CARE program receive a 20% discount on their bill.

The primary drivers for this rate decrease include the following:

- Excess revenues collected in the previous year, decreasing transportation rates
- Which are partially offset by:
- Increased costs related to uncollected residential accounts, greenhouse gas compliance, and SoCalGas's gas transportation system, increasing transportation rates
 - Cost increases for the California Alternate Rates for Energy (CARE) and Energy Efficiency programs, increasing public purpose surcharge rates

¹ Bundled rates shown assume a gas core procurement rate of \$0.559/therm as shown in Advice Letter 3261-G. Core procurement rates are established monthly and may be higher or lower.

² Non-CARE bill estimate based on a typical non-CARE customer average monthly usage of 24 therms per month. CARE bill estimate based on a typical CARE customer average monthly usage of 20 therms per month. Usage in colder months, like January, typically exceeds the average monthly usage, which would result in higher bills for those months than reflected. All figures shown assume a gas core procurement rate of \$0.559/therm as shown in Advice Letter 3261-G.
