SRMAP offers Aggregators something different. As a population-level NMEC program, SRMAP opens opportunities to capture stranded energy savings and earn increased incentives for energy savings delivered during summer peak (4-7 p.m.) and net-peak (7-9 p.m.) hours. Both residential and non-residential projects are eligible for SRMAP incentives.

What is an Aggregator?

An Aggregator is a participating vendor or program partner who works with customers to generate energy efficiency and/or demand savings for a group of customers. Aggregators manage interactions and relationships with the customer from project identification to customer implementation. Eligibility rules may be found in the Program Manual and Aggregator Participation Agreement available for download at sdge.com/SRMAP.

What measures can be installed?

SRMAP does not prescribe specific measures. The program is open to all measure types in all customer sectors, including savings for bringing below code equipment To-Code.

All projects must be installed by March 31, 2024 or before all funds have been reserved, whichever comes first. Visit the program website at sdge.com/SRMAP for project eligibility requirements.

What incentives are offered?

SRMAP incentive rates are based on the value to the grid as defined by the Avoided Cost Calculator. Incentive payments will be



calculated based on energy savings delivered and the appropriate load curves and a weighted EUL. Payments to Aggregators will be made on a quarterly basis for one year after a project has been installed. An upfront Installation payment to help offset project costs is available for qualifying projects.
