



## Senate Bill 1210: Estimated Costs and Timelines for New Service

In compliance with [California Senate Bill 1210](#), SDG&E® is providing average project cost and timeline estimates for typical, new, residential-electric and mixed-fuel (gas and electric) service projects under [Electric Rule 16](#) and [Gas Rule 16](#). These estimates are based on historical data and are intended to help customers plan for upcoming service requests.

Please keep in mind that these figures are **planning estimates only**—actual costs and timelines may vary depending on your project's specific requirements and site conditions.

Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU)	\$1,000	\$2,400	176
Mixed-Use Development	\$7,000	\$47,000	458
