## **NOTICE OF SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY'S RATE INCREASE REQUEST**

**San Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E®) General Rate Case Application to the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) A.26-06-015**

### **What is being requested?**

SDG&E is requesting an increase in revenue of \$280 million (8.1%) from estimated 2027 revenues to: pay for wildfire mitigation, modernization of the natural gas system and electric grid, improvements in technology, improving customer experience, and address rising costs, like insurance.

SDG&E is also seeking a formula to address inflation and additional capital investments that, if approved, will increase revenues by an additional \$327 million or 8.7% in 2029, \$226 million or 5.5% in 2030, and \$240 million or 5.6% in 2031.

If approved, SDG&E will implement new revenues in rates beginning on January 1, 2028.

### How would this impact the average residential Customer?

For electric service, if the request is approved, the typical bundled residential customer using 400 kWh per month would see a bill increase of approximately \$14.03 per month. The actual impact will vary based on usage, baseline territory, and other factors.

For gas service, if the request is approved, the average residential customer using 24 therms per month would see a bill increase of approximately \$8.45 per month.<sup>2</sup> The actual impact will vary based on usage, baseline territory, and other factors.

### Additional information

An administrative law judge will hold hearings, consider evidence, testimony, and public comments before drafting a proposed decision on this application. CPUC Commissioners will then vote on a final decision at a public meeting.
