Amount: Last year, up to a \$500** SDG&E® bill credit was given to drivers that applied.

When: Enrollment starts in March. To receive the credit, your vehicle must be registered in California and within SDG&E's service area as of May 31, 2019.

Where to apply: Review the qualifications and apply for the credit at **sdge.com/EVCC**.
