

Get a bill credit for driving an electric vehicle

As part of California's effort to fight climate change, if you drive an all-electric or plug-in hybrid electric vehicle, you may be eligible to receive an annual **Electric Vehicle Climate Credit**. Last year, drivers that applied received a credit of \$200.*

The credit is only for electric vehicles registered at a residence, it's not for commercial fleets. To receive the credit, your vehicle must be registered in the state of California with an address within SDG&E's service area as of May 31, 2018.

This program is not funded by utility rates but by regulation meant to increase the adoption of clean-vehicle fuels such as electricity.

Enrollment starts on March 1, 2018. Review the qualifications and apply for the credit at **sdge.com/evcc**.

Remember, you can pay less at the plug with EV time of use rates. Rates are lower when you program your EV to charge from midnight to 6 a.m. Visit **sdge.com/evrates** to learn more.
