- f. Replacement equipment must be programmed to operate outside of peak hours. Peak hours are 4:00 PM to 9:00 PM
- g. Replacement equipment must be purchased on/after 1/13/2020, and must be installed before 12/31/2020
- h. Installer must provide program's Notice of Data Collection document to the residential customer, as part of complying with the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA)
- i. Pumps being replaced must be disposed of rather than refurbished and sold
- j. Replacement equipment must be purchased through an approved distributor and/or retailer. Cannot purchase online.
- k. Customer and contractor acknowledgement and signature are required
- I. Installations are subject to inspection by SDG&E and/or the California Public Utilities Commission in order to verify that installations are complete and comply with the Rebate terms and conditions
