Reference: Annual Update to Transmission Revenue Balancing Account Adjustment

On October 29, 2018, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) filed revisions to Appendix III of its Transmission Owner Tariff to reflect the annual update to its Transmission Revenue Balancing Account Adjustment (TRBAA). For 2019, SDG&E proposes a wholesale TRBAA—for purposes of calculating the California Independent System Operator Corporation Transmission Access Charge—of negative \$7,329,369, and a retail TRBAA of negative \$7,341,993, passed through using a TRBAA rate of negative \$0.00039 per kWh. The proposed tariff revisions are accepted for filing, effective January 1, 2019, as requested.

The filing was noticed on October 30, 2018, with comments, protests, or interventions due on or before November 19, 2018. No protests or adverse comments were filed. Notices of intervention and unopposed timely filed motions to intervene are granted pursuant to the operation of Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R § 385.214). Any opposed or untimely filed motion to intervene is governed by the provisions of Rule 214.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, contract, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made

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by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against SDG&E.

Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
