Local Capacity Procurement Program



SAVE WHILE ENABLING COMFORTABLE AND EFFICIENT FACILITIES

Qualifying building owners can receive increased financial incentives, based on electrical capacity savings, to upgrade and improve the efficiency of mechanical systems.

The Local Capacity Procurement Program (LCPP) is a program administered by SDG&E and implemented by, our program contractor, Willdan. It helps address the complex challenges facing many building owners such as minimizing energy consumption while maintaining tenant comfort and maximizing net operating income. The Program offers cash incentives to commercial building owners for HVAC system improvements.

What type of building owners would benefit?

- All leased or rented commercial facilities.
- Owner-occupied commercial facilities used for: Banking, Insurance, Retail Merchandising; Information Services and Telecommunications Services.
- Businesses that perform routine support for day-to-day operations of organizations.

Requirements

- The LCPP Owner Incentive Agreement must be executed prior to the installation of any equipment.
- Projects must remain operational and verifiable by Willdan and SDG&E through 2023.
- Facility must be in SDG&E service territory.
