SDG&E provides additional options available for residential customers with electric vehicles. Schedules EV-TOU and EV-TOU-2 are SDG&E's residential rates for customers with an electric car or use electricity to run a natural gas home fueling pump. The car must be registered with the California Department of Motor Vehicles.

Schedule EV-TOU - DOMESTIC TIME-OF-USE FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING is specific to the charging of electric vehicles where the charging facility is separately metered. Effective 1/1/2024
