**San Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E®)
2027 Energy Resource Recovery Account
(ERRA) Forecast and 2027 Electric Sales
Forecast Application to the California Public
Utilities Commission (CPUC) A.26-05-009**

What is being requested?

San Diego Gas and Electric Company requests a total increase in revenue of \$13.2 million, which covers forecasted costs of purchasing electricity and expenses related to ensuring reliable electric service. Additionally, SDG&E is proposing an update to its sales forecast, which is used to set rates, resulting in varying class average rate impacts.¹

SDG&E does not profit from the cost of purchasing electricity on behalf of customers. If the actual costs are different from forecasted, SDG&E will return the difference to customers or collect the shortfall from customers.

SDG&E will update this application later in the year to include the latest information, market conditions, and decisions from the CPUC. Because market prices can change, the rate and bill impacts might be different from what is shown here.

How would this impact the average residential customer?

If the request is approved, the typical bundled residential customer using 400 kWh would see a bill decrease of approximately (\$0.38) per month.⁴ The actual impact will vary based on usage, baseline territory, and other factors.

Additional information

An administrative law judge will hold hearings, consider evidence, testimony, and public comments before drafting a proposed decision on this application. CPUC Commissioners will then vote on a final decision at a public meeting.
