SoCalGas uses the G-NGV meter serving each of the SoCalGas public access CNG stations to measure total station volume and dispenser meters at each public access CNG station to measure public-access sales. The difference between total station volume and public access sales is associated with private fleet fueling.

b. Please provide a breakdown of the total volumes attributable to customer sales and the total volumes attributable to private fleet refueling.
