SDG&E's TY 2024 10 forecast for Miscellaneous Revenues was revised from \$34.121 million to \$36.782 million in the 11 Revised Direct Testimony (Ex. SDG&E-42-R) and Revised Workpapers (Ex. SDG&E-42-WP-12 R) of Christine Fischer. The TY 2024 forecast was revised primarily to include Net Energy 13 Metering Fees and was offset by adjustments to other Electric Miscellaneous Revenues in 14 SDG&E's rate case.<sup>4</sup>
