

Power Your Drive for Fleets

HVIP Funding 2022

Administered by the California Air Resources Board (CARB), HVIP is California's most popular and fleet-friendly clean vehicle funding program.

HVIP is a voucher-based program that makes hundreds of millions of dollars in funding available to California fleet operators.

HVIP vouchers apply directly to vehicle purchase price-reducing your up-front vehicle cost.

Program Name	Hybrid and Zero Emission Truck and Bus Voucher Incentive Project (HVIP)
Open Date	Funding will be available in March 2022. A portion of funding dedicated to Innovative Small e-Fleets will be available at a later date.
Due Date	First-come, first-served. Funding will go fast!
Eligible Vehicles	HVIP Eligible Vehicle Catalog
BEV Per Unit Funding	Approximately \$45,000 - \$252,000 available per vehicle. HVIP also offers an additional 15% for qualifying projects in disadvantaged communities, 15% for public transit agencies, and 65% for public schools. Voucher amounts will be modified based on application and vehicle type.
Maximum Funding	Applicants cannot request more than 30 vouchers per year, per tax identification number (with the exception of drayage fleets which can request up to 50 vouchers). If stacked with another funding source; the combined incentives cannot exceed 90% of the total vehicle cost (minus taxes and fees) for private entities or 100% of the total vehicle cost (minus taxes and fees) for public entities.
Location	Awardees must commit to operate the vehicle 100% within California for at least 3 years after the voucher redemption date. Class 8 freight trucks, including port drayage trucks, may accrue up to 50% of their mileage each year outside of California without prior approval, as long as goods are being transported to or from California.



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HOW TO APPLY

Now is the time to check that the vehicles you want and dealers you use are approved.

Coordinate with your dealers to make sure they are prepared to submit vouchers on your behalf. Requesting a voucher will require the following information. Dealers submit vouchers on behalf of a fleet.

- If the vehicle is leased, vouchers require the lessor's name, email, phone number, and a point of contact. A reminder, the lessor is not the applicant. The fleet operating the vehicle is the applicant.
- Information about additional funding sources including the date you
 received any additional funding, or expect to, the funding source, and
 the amount awarded per vehicle.
- Approved vehicle (manufacturer, vehicle type, model year, description)
- Vehicle Quantity
- Fleet Size
- Fleet point of contact (name, company, address, phone, email, FEIN)
- Voucher enhancement (if applicable)
- TRUCRS ID and DOT #
- Fleet domicile address (if different than the company address)
- VIN (production name may be provided for the first 60 days if VIN is not yet available)
- Purchase Order (dated within 30 days of HVIP opening for private fleets OR after 1/1/2022 for public fleets)

Be prepared to provide clarification or additional information within 10 days of submitting your voucher request to maintain its viability.

⊘ Prepare applications ASAP!

HVIP funding is the most popular electric vehicle funding program in California. Available funds will go quickly in this "first-come, first-served" program. Work with your dealers early to ensure they are fully prepared to submit on your behalf.

⊘ Stay up to date!

A new HVIP implementation manual will be available February 2022.

Check for and maintain regulatory compliance prior to application.

Fleets must remain compliant at all times with all applicable federal, state, and/or local regulations, and all applicable regulatory advisories.

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
